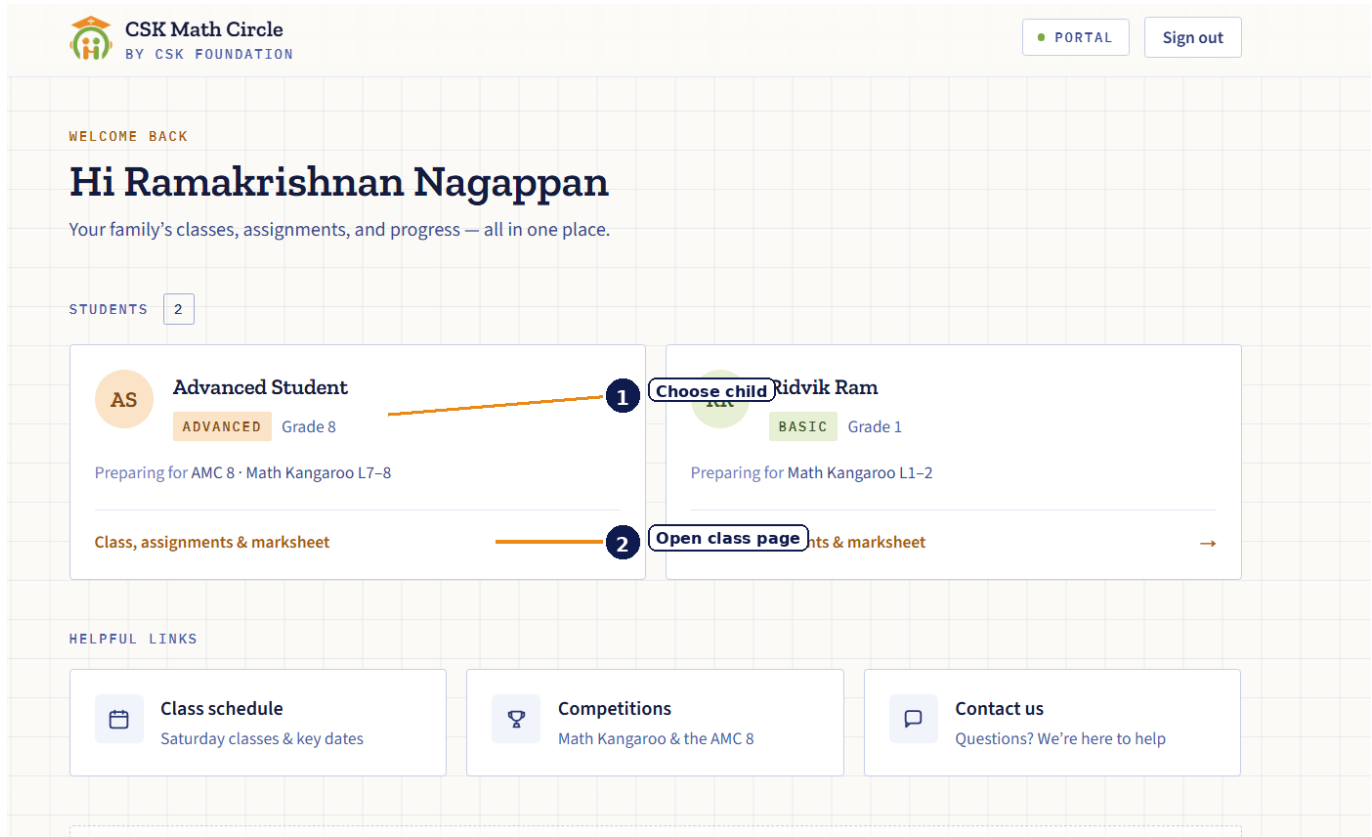

What does “What's covered” show?

It shows the current lesson and the topics in that learning block.

Classes are live and are not recorded. Missing a class carries no penalty, but that topic may not be repeated later in the year.

HOMEWORK & MARKSHEET

Practice sets and progress

Homework is optional practice; the portal keeps scores and feedback in one place.

1 OPEN Practice opens the day before class.	2 ANSWER Choose answers in the portal.	3 HAND IN Tell the teacher you are finished.
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HOMEWORK

- Practice sets appear under Homework on your child's page.
- They open the day before the corresponding class.
- Homework is optional. There is no penalty for skipping it.
- Questions are multiple choice. Nothing needs to be photographed or uploaded.
- Print this homework is available if your child prefers paper; answers are still entered in the portal afterward.

WHEN WORK IS MARKED

- Scores do not appear immediately. A person reviews and approves each score and comment first.
- Approved practice sets can be opened question by question.
- You can see your child's answer, whether it was correct, and a written explanation.
- In-person tests return as a score only. The copyrighted test paper is not reproduced in the portal.

Practice score vs. benchmark score

Home practice may be completed with a parent nearby. In-person benchmark tests are completed independently. If the two scores drift apart, use that as a guide to topics your child may need to review. Whenever possible, let your child choose their own answers at home.

NO MAKE-UPS | IN PERSON ONLY

The in-person tests and tournament cannot be taken remotely or on another day.

COMMON QUESTIONS

Can we get a recording of a missed class? No. Classes are live and not recorded.	Is homework required? No. Homework is optional practice.
Why is homework empty? Practice opens the day before the corresponding class.	Why is there no score yet? Scores appear after review and approval.
Can a benchmark be taken remotely or on another day? No. There are no remote or make-up sittings.	Do I need separate accounts for multiple children? No. One family account can show multiple students.
